MONDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2026 We officially begin our Arizona Adventure Out West today! Gather at Jackson – Medgar Evers Airport for an early morning departure, headed to Phoenix. Arizona is one of America’s most unique and beautiful states to explore, and this week will be a memorable experience as we tour four of its most visited towns and cities. Upon arrival at Sky Harbor Airport in Phoenix, we will load our luggage onto our luxury motorcoach for the week. We will see the Arizona State Capitol Building, built of native stone and surrounded by a landscape featuring a large variety of native trees, shrubs, and cacti. While in Phoenix, we will take a break for lunch at a local favorite restaurant (on your own). After lunch, we will take a short drive to Scottsdale, one of the most vibrant and enchanting areas in Arizona. In Old Town Scottsdale, we’ll explore a charming neighborhood filled with shopping opportunities that capture the Old West feel. This is the perfect spot to pick up turquoise jewelry, unique boutique items, and local artwork. We will also visit several art galleries showcasing paintings and stunning works made of glass, copper, and minerals. After a fun afternoon exploring Old Town, we will transfer to our Scottsdale hotel, where we will stay for the next two evenings. You will have some free time to relax this afternoon.

Enjoy dinner tonight on your own at the popular Old Town Tortilla Factory, known for its unique outdoor seating and delicious Southwestern cuisine. A perfect way to end our first day!

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 20 – Enjoy a hot deluxe breakfast, included at our hotel this morning. Following breakfast, we will embark on a VIP Scottsdale experience as we travel into the Arizona backcountry to a locally owned ranch. Here, we will meet our guides and experience the true spirit of the Old West! Step back in time as you explore an authentic Arizona town reminiscent of days gone by. You'll feel as though you've stepped onto the set of a classic Western starring John Wayne or Clint Eastwood. While we are touring the ranch, a delicious grilled lunch will be prepared for us and is included today. After lunch, we'll venture into the backcountry for a scenic ride, offering close-up views of Arizona's iconic cacti and opportunities to spot roadrunners and other local wildlife. Following our memorable ranch experience, we will return to Scottsdale. The remainder of the afternoon is yours to enjoy at leisure. You may choose to return to Old Town Scottsdale on our motorcoach for additional shopping and sightseeing or perhaps indulge in a relaxing spa treatment—one of the experiences Scottsdale is famous for. This evening, enjoy dinner on your own in Old Town Scottsdale, where you'll find a variety of outstanding restaurants and dining options. After dinner, we have one more special treat in store as we take an evening ride around historic Camelback Mountain, offering unforgettable views of the Valley of the Sun. (B,L)

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 21 -- Enjoy a deluxe hot breakfast, included at our hotel this morning. After breakfast, we will gather our luggage, check out of the hotel, and depart for Sedona. Our first stop today is Montezuma Castle National Monument, where we will marvel at Arizona's most famous cliff dwellings. More than 800 years old, these remarkably preserved structures are among the finest examples of ancient Native American architecture in the Southwest. Later in the day, we arrive in Sedona, the picturesque artist resort town located at the southern entrance to Oak Creek Canyon. Upon arrival, we will check into our hotel, which will be our home for the next two nights. Enjoy a relaxing afternoon taking in Sedona's spectacular red rock scenery and exploring the many unique shops, galleries, and boutiques that line Main Street. This evening, we will travel to Cottonwood for a memorable visit to the Blazin' M Ranch. Our Western adventure comes to life as we enjoy a variety of activities, including axe throwing, visiting baby Highland cows, exploring the Western petting zoo, riding the Blazin' M Express, and participating in other fun ranch activities. The highlight of the evening is a delicious Western-style dinner, complete with all the fixins', followed by a lively country-western show featuring outstanding music, comedy, and entertainment. THURSDAY, OCTOBER 22 -- After breakfast, we will explore the beauty of Sedona, beginning with a visit to the Chapel of the Holy Cross. Recognized by *Architectural Digest* as one of the ten most beautiful churches in the world, this remarkable chapel is built into Sedona's stunning red rock landscape. We will learn about its history and have time for prayer and reflection, if you'd like. Next, we will board the Verde Canyon

Wilderness Railroad for a scenic four-hour journey through Arizona's spectacular backcountry. Traveling from Clarkdale to Perkinsville and back, the route features dramatic canyon views, vintage trestles, a 734-foot tunnel, and ancient Indian ruins. These historic tracks were built around towering red-rock splendor along the riparian curves of the Verde River. The 4 hour train ride near Sedona offers an easy adventure into the backcountry of this river-carved canyon without having to put on hiking boots! Complimentary snacks and beverages are included, and guests may enjoy both open-air and indoor seating. After our rail adventure, we will return to downtown Sedona, where you will have time to enjoy dinner on your own at one of the area's many excellent restaurants before returning to the hotel. (B)

FRIDAY OCTOBER 23 -- After breakfast, we will check out of our hotel and travel north through beautiful Oak Creek Canyon, passing dramatic red rock cliffs and scenic overlooks on our way toward the Grand Canyon. Upon arrival, we will stop at the Grand Canyon Visitor Center before viewing the IMAX film *Grand Canyon: The Hidden Secrets*, offering a fascinating introduction to one of the world's greatest natural wonders. Next, we will experience the Grand Canyon up close on a guided Pink Jeep Tour along the South Rim. Highlights include spectacular viewpoints along Desert View Drive, Navajo Point, the Desert View Watchtower, and stunning views of the Colorado River, while learning about the canyon's geology and history. A boxed sandwich lunch is included during our tour. Following our unforgettable day at the Grand Canyon, we will travel to the Grand Canyon Railway Hotel and check in for the evening. Dinner will be on your own, with the option to dine at the hotel or at one of the nearby local restaurants. (B, L)

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 24 – Enjoy a delicious hot breakfast at the historic Fred Harvey Restaurant, included this morning. After breakfast, we will load our luggage, check out of the hotel, and begin our journey back to Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport for our flight home. We will arrive home by early evening, bringing with us wonderful memories, beautiful photos, and unforgettable experiences from our Arizona adventure. (B)
